
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ABSTRACT

Reading comprehension is the ability to understand and comprehend written text that is read. It involves identifying the meaning of words, phrases, sentences and paragraphs. From the results of the preliminary study conducted, it was found that students' speaking skills were still very low. Therefore, the purpose of this study is to investigate the effectiveness of total physical response in Improving Reading Comprehension, because previous research shows that the use of total physical response can improve students' Reading Comprehension. The approach of this research was quantitative data with a pre-experimental design using pre-test and post-test, the subjects of this study are eighth grade students of MTs lubbul labib consisting of 27 students. The instruments used in collecting the data are tests and instruments used in collecting the data are tests. the instrument used in collecting data is a test. data about students' progress in Improving Reading Comprehension is taken from post-test data. therefore, total physical response succeeds in making students motivated and learning more fun, this can be proven from the students' mean score in post-test (81,03) higher than pre-test (41,11) and T-test value is greater than the T-table value ($13.261 > 1.703$). Therefore, the null hypothesis (H_0) was rejected and the alternative hypothesis (H_1) accepted. Thus, total physical response is effective for students' Reading Comprehension.

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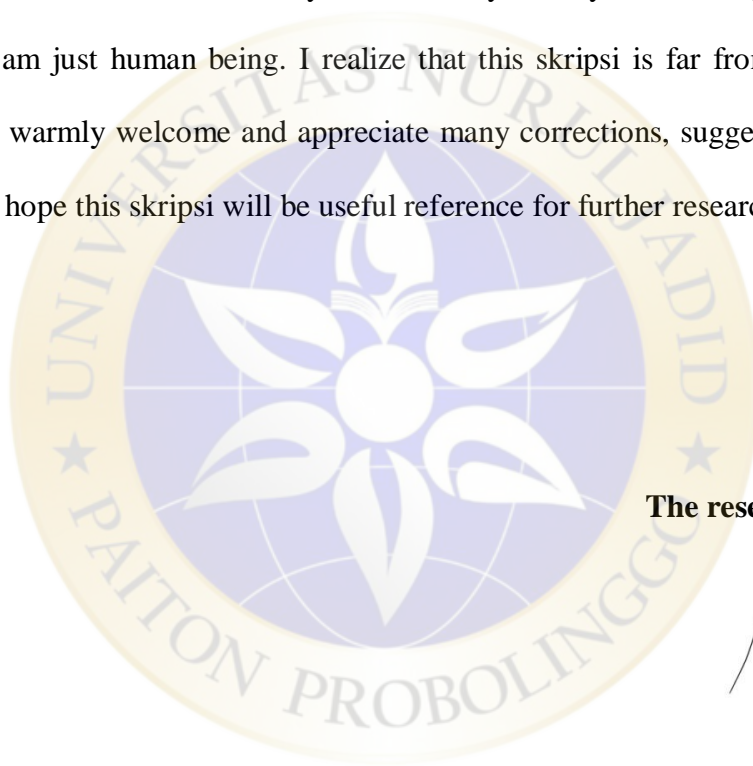
