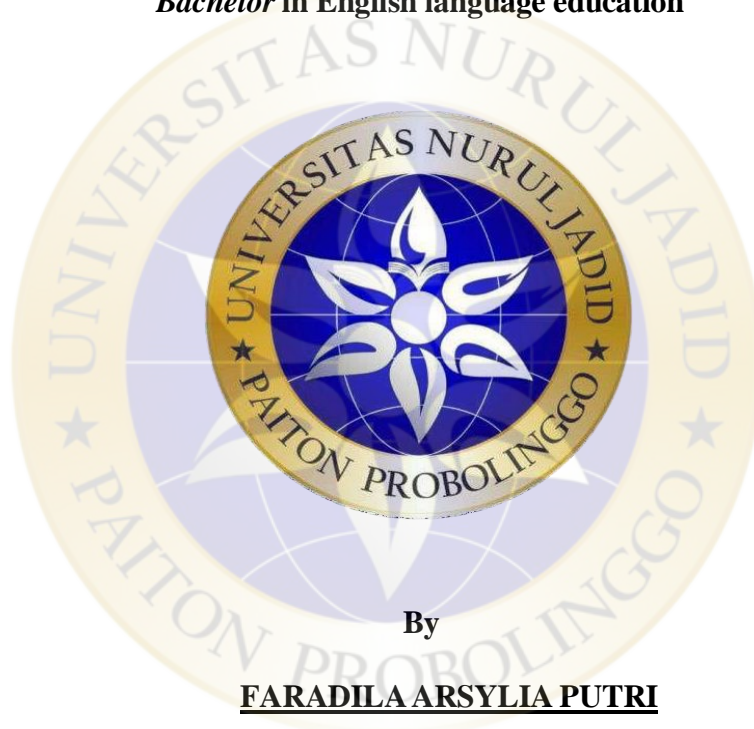



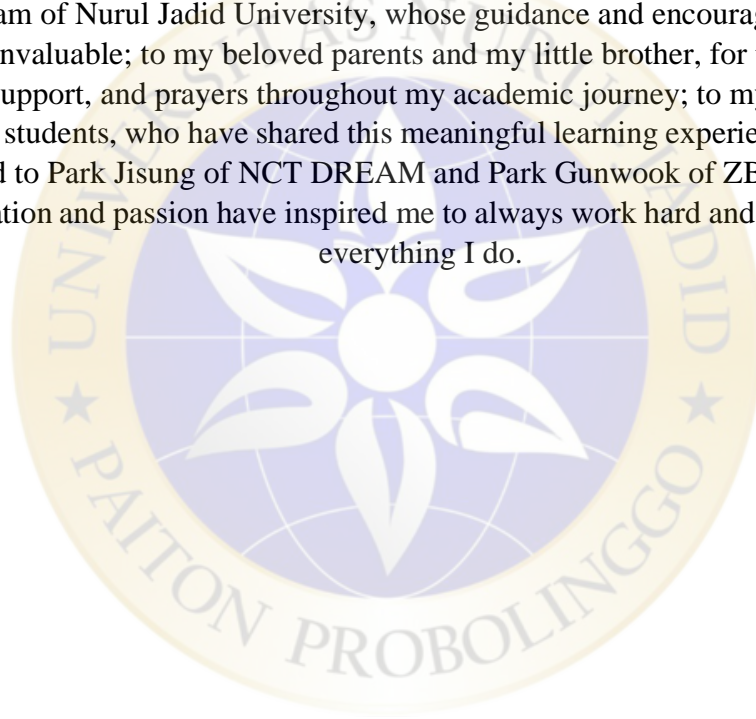

ABSTARCT

Keyword: : *Pesantren environment , English speaking skills, Oprimization.*

This study aims to optimize the pesantren environment to enhance students' English speaking skills through action research at Pesantren Nurul Jadid. Using a descriptive qualitative method, the researcher involved five eighth-semester female students of the English Education Program who actively participated in pesantren language programs. Data were collected through interviews, observations, and documentation, then analyzed using thematic analysis. The findings revealed that structured language programs, peer collaboration, teacher role modeling, and integration of English into religious activities significantly supported students' speaking development. However, several challenges were also identified, including inconsistent policy implementation, psychological barriers, and limited exposure to fluent English use. This research emphasizes that a supportive environment, consistent language policy, and contextual learning opportunities are key to improving students' speaking proficiency. The results are expected to contribute to the development of pesantren-based English learning strategies in Indonesia.
