

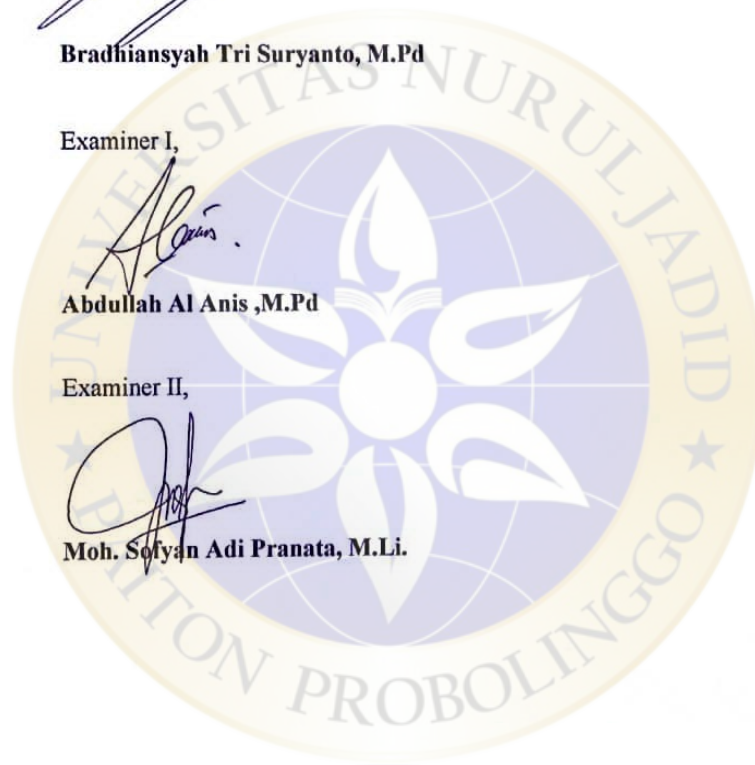

ABSTRACT

The aim of this study is to investigate what are the English students' attitude toward the use of google translate in learning process. The method used in this study is qualitative method. It contains research results that obtain data in the form of words, phrases or images derived from documents, observations and interviews results. In collecting data, researcher used several steps that have been compiled to find out the what are the attitudes of English Education Department students at Nurul Jadid University towards the use of google translate. Researcher used observation and interview for collecting the data. The respondent in this study consist 25 students A-class in 8th semester at Nurul Jadid University.

Based on the results of interviews, there are three component of attitudes such as behavior component, cognitive component and affective component. In behavior component discuss about the use of google translate and the reason use of google translate. Most students use of google translate is to check the meaning of unknown words, then to translate sentences, and next to translate paragraphs. In addition, the least use of google translate is to check synonyms, translate the entire essay and the last is to translate part of the essay or article consisting of 2 or more paragraphs. In cognitive component discuss about the students responses about google translate. The most dominant response is that they state that the use of GT is acceptable regardless of how it is used and the last is affective component is discuss about the students' feelings about google translate. They stated that there were several feelings they experienced in using GT. The most dominant feeling is that they felt so-so and enjoy using GT, besides that other feelings they experience are dependence, embarrassment and confidence when using google translate.
