

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

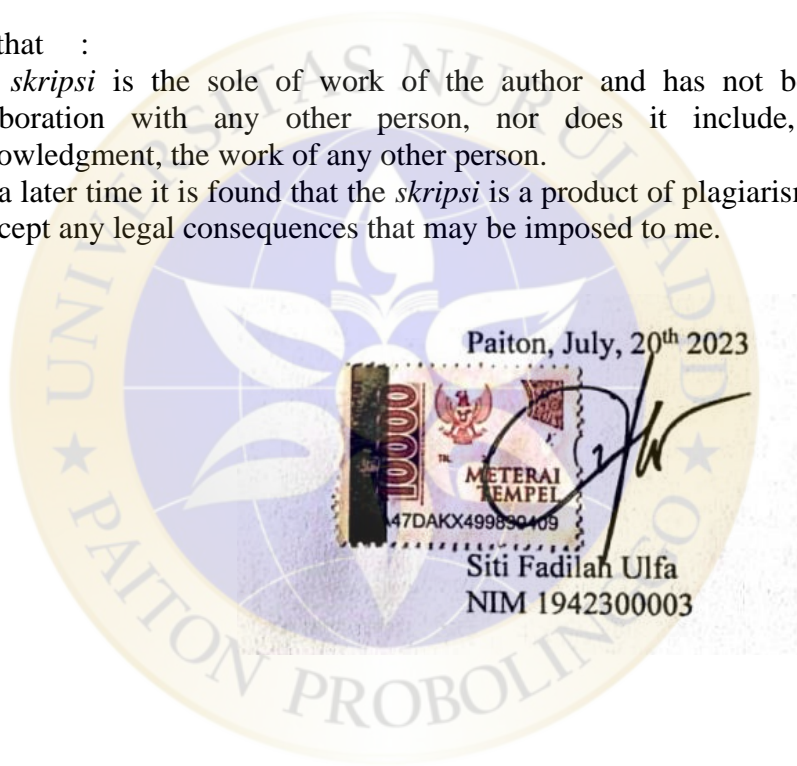

ABSTRACT

This study aims to investigate students' perspectives on Grammar learning using TikTok. Researcher used research with a qualitative descriptive type approach. Collecting data used observation and interviews on open-ended questions adapted from previous studies. The stages of data analysis in this study used the method according to Miles & Huberman. According to Miles & Huberman, and researcher use the Flow Model in this study where the stages are data reduction, data display and conclusion Drawing/Verification. In this study the researcher used 7 students in the elementary class at the Darul Hikmah dormitory. The results of this study describe the three perception indicators proposed by Walgito (2010).

In the findings resulting from data information, it was found that for each perception indicator proposed by Walgito (2010), students have positive and negative perceptions of learning Grammar using TikTok. Besides that, there are several factors that influence their perceptions, namely internal factors and also external factors. As for external factors because the understanding explained by the teacher is still lacking in detail for some students so they have a negative perception of learning using TikTok. On the other hand, students feel learning using TikTok was fun and make students more enthusiastic in learning Grammar, and it makes students have a positive perception of learning through TikTok. Furthermore, internal factors that influence students were that students feel happy and excited so that learning Grammar used TikTok resulting in positive perceptions, while some students feel that their abilities to understand the material was low, thus caused some of these students have a negative perception of TikTok as a learning medium. Based on the research that has been done, the researcher found several weaknesses in this study. The weakness is that recommended learning videos for students do not explain in detail. Therefore, due to the limitations of the researcher in conducting research, The researcher suggests that future research teachers related to Grammar and TikTok can create Grammar learning videos in accordance with the material to be conveyed in detail and that future researcher is expected to be able to find a theory that determines the occurrence of perceptions held by students in learning English using TikTok. Thus, the findings of future researcher can explain more significantly and more deeply about the perspectives held by students.
