
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
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

In conducting the research, the researcher uses a qualitative approach with narrative inquiry analysis as the research methodology. The participants consist of seven students of English Education Department and the data collection technique used in this research is in-depth interview. After that, the data did analyse.

Based on the result of this study, participants' stories regarding their educational background, personal experiences, and cultural context indicate that these aspects very affected their beliefs on English as an International Language (EIL), interest to learn English, speaking in English, and so on. This study highlights the importance of understanding these beliefs, as they significantly influence pre-service teachers' teaching practices and attitudes toward language education. It is recommended to the study program to emphasize the policies related to the obligation of English Education Department students before becoming pre-service teachers to communicate in English during the teaching learning process in the classroom. By that they will be able to be more confident when teaching English in their classroom in the future. It is also recommended to the next researchers to conduct the similarity research into students of other semesters and with other methods and instruments. And to the students to make a habit in communicating in English and have experiences regarding to English, such becoming private English teachers and an English mentor.
