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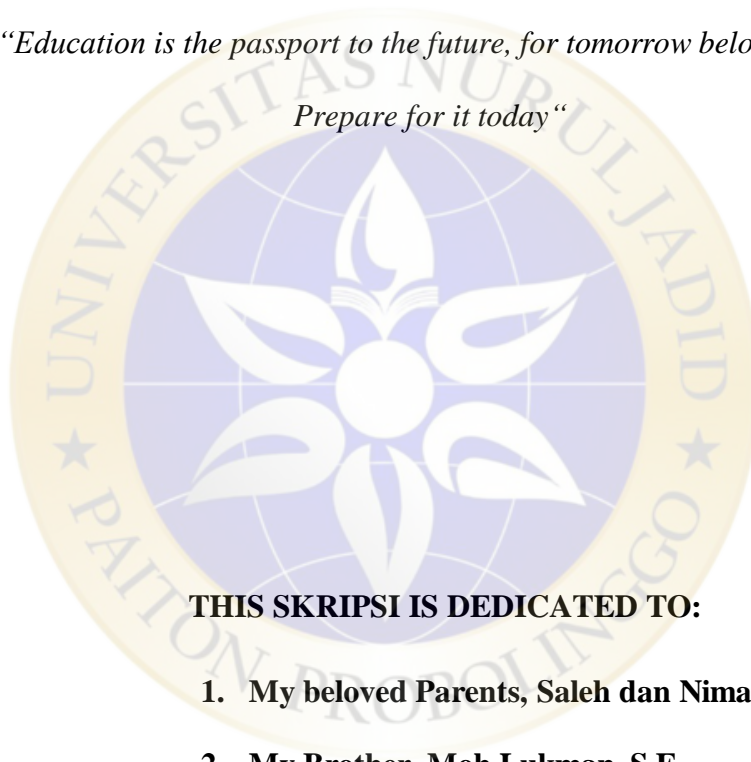

ABSTRACT

This study aimed to explore students' experiences utilizing grammar to improve their english speaking competence. Specifically, the research focused on the obstacles students faced in applying grammar when speaking, the aspects of speaking ability that could be improved through grammar mastery, and the factors that affected the effectiveness of grammar in oral communication. A qualitative approach with a narrative inquiry design was used to explore students' subjective experiences in-depth. Data collection instruments included semi-structured interviews and participant observations. The data were analyzed using a thematic analysis approach, which involved coding, identifying themes, and interpreting the meaning of participants' narratives. The findings showed that grammar mastery significantly contributed to improved clarity, fluency, and logical thinking in speaking. However, grammar mastery alone did not guarantee smooth oral communication, as students encountered challenges such as lack of confidence, limited speaking practice, and interference from their mother tongue. External factors such as a supportive learning environment, the use of technology, and the quality of teaching also influenced the effectiveness of grammar in speaking. Therefore, a holistic and contextual teaching approach was deemed necessary for grammar to function effectively in oral communication. These findings highlight the complex interplay between linguistic knowledge and communicative performance, indicating that grammar should be taught in an integrated way rather than in isolation. The role of external factors emphasizes the need for collaborative efforts among teachers, institutions, and students in fostering speaking competence. Grammar mastery improves essential aspects of speaking, yet its effectiveness depends on learners' psychological readiness, sufficient practice, and supportive educational contexts. It is recommended that educators adopt contextualized and communicative grammar teaching approaches, provide more opportunities for authentic speaking practice, and integrate technology to create engaging learning environments.

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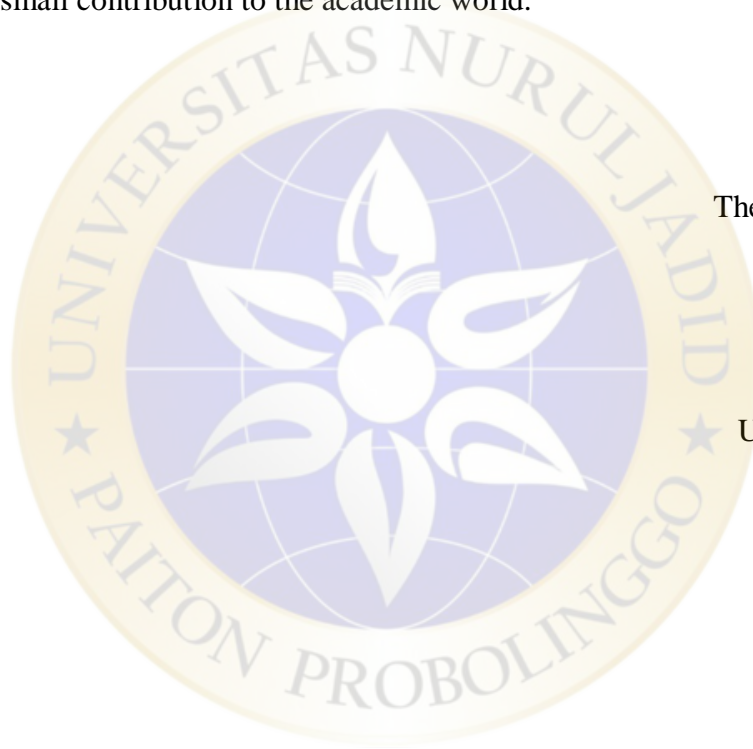
